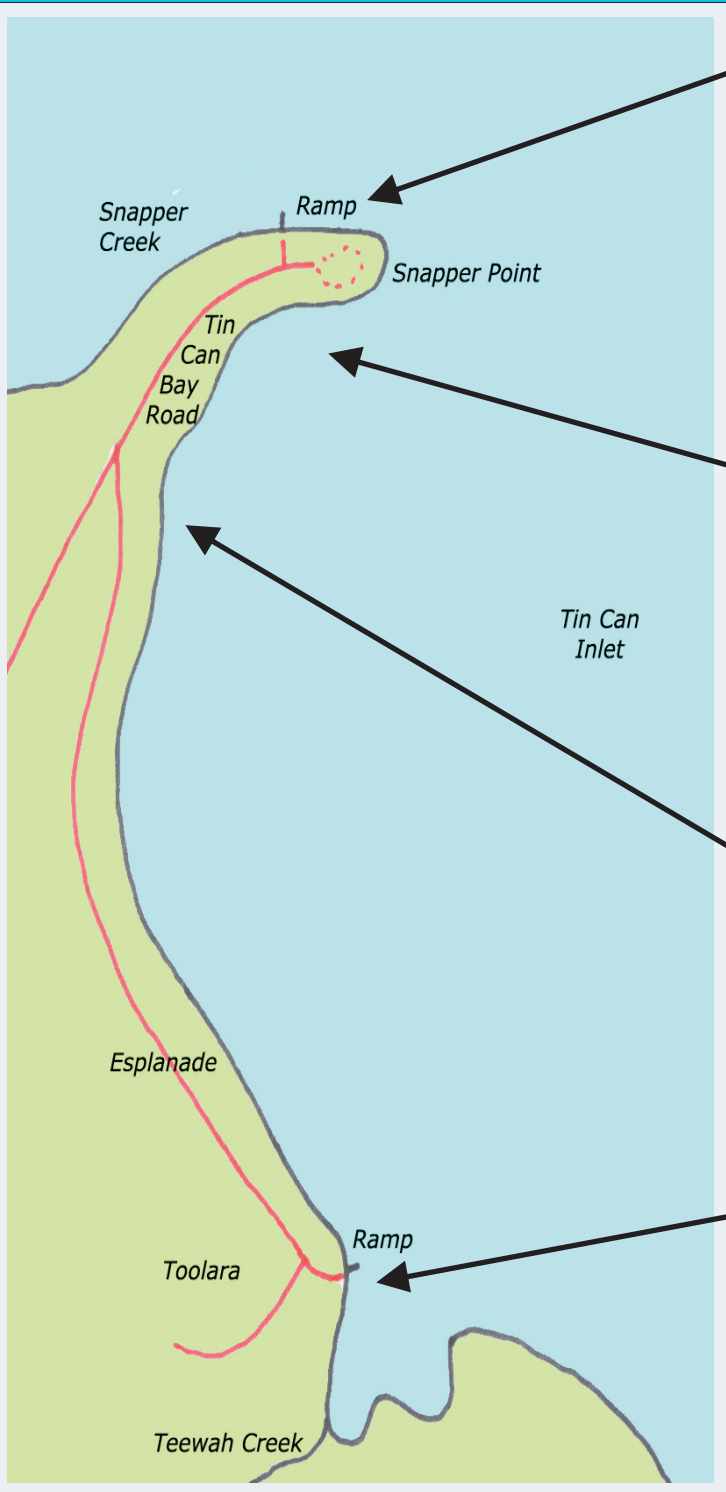




QUEENSLAND'S POPULAR LAND BASED FISHING AREAS
