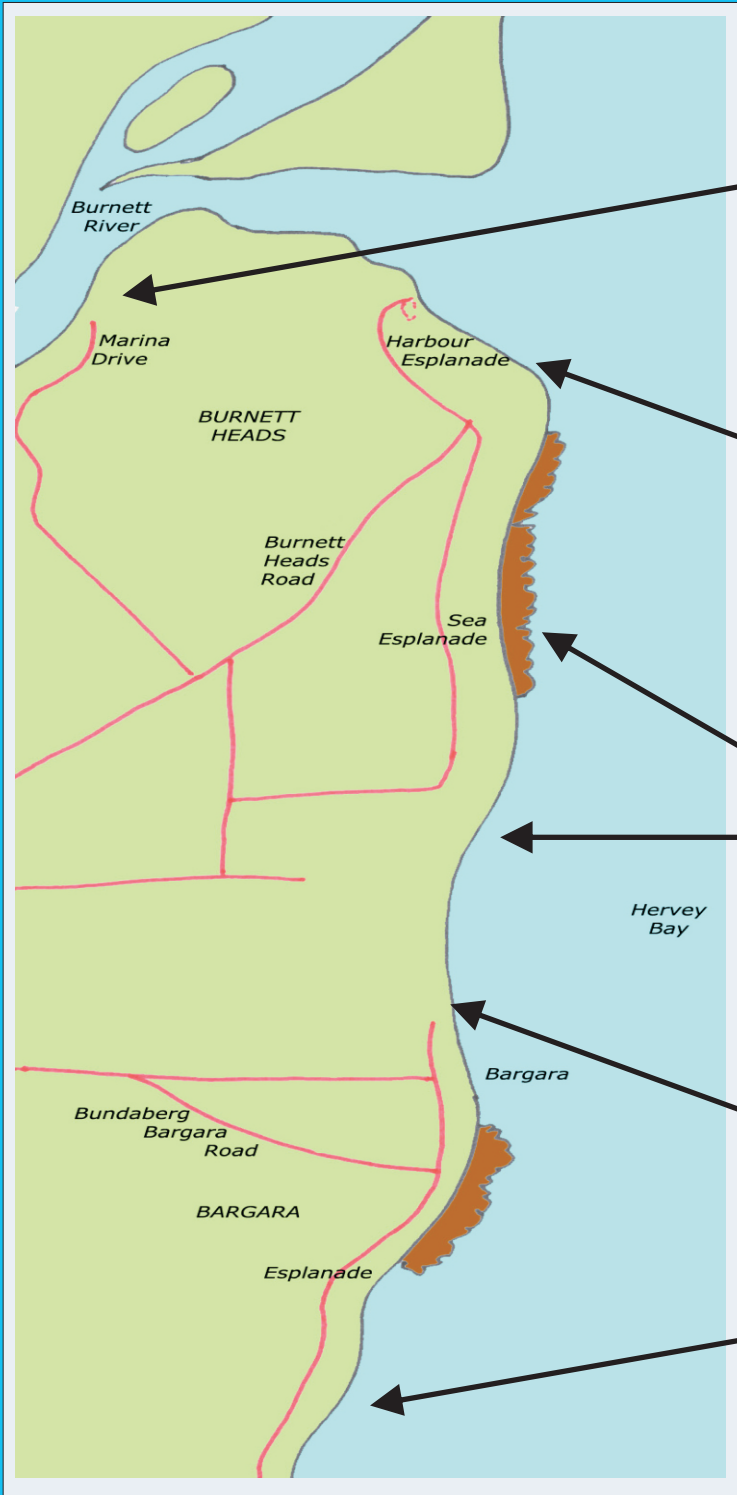




QUEENSLAND'S POPULAR LAND BASED FISHING AREAS

COMMON SPECIES Bream; Whiting; Flathead

COMMON SPECIES Bream; Whiting; Flathead

AREA Burnett Heads foreshore
ACCESS Via Sea Esplanade
DESCRIPTION Rocky foreshore & some sandy beach
BEST TIDE Low water
SUGGESTED BAITS Prawns, yabbies, worms, flesh bait
COMMON SPECIES Bream; Whiting; Flathead; Rock species

LOCATION NUMBER 50: 196
AREA Bargara beaches & foreshore
ACCESS Via Esplanade & parking areas
DESCRIPTION Rocky foreshore & some sand beaches
BEST TIDE All tides
SUGGESTED BAITS Prawns, yabbies, worms, flesh bait
COMMON SPECIES Bream; Whiting; Flathead; Rock species
